It is the only parish church other than Westminster Abbey which is still in use in which a coronation has taken place. On 29th July, 1567, James, son of Mary, Queen of Scots was crowned James VI of Scotland (later to be also James 1 of England) on the forced abdication of his mother. The church is open to visitors from 11am until 4pm over Easter and then seven days a week from 1 May until the end of September, and for worship on Sunday at the appropriate times. Over 50,000 visitors from more than 60 countries visited in 2014. A brief history of the church is available for visitors in 84 languages. This is our specialist ministry.
