We are led by a friendly bunch of people – some students, some not. We are overseen by recognised Church leaders.



Our goal is to grow in the grace and knowledge of Jesus Christ, and to make disciples by bringing others to know him too. We therefore focus on expository preaching during our Sunday services, with a mix of old and new styles of worship. We also prioritise outreach by equipping and enabling members to live distinctive Christian lives wherever they work, study and live. Alongside this we run events such as Christianity Explored, and have a concern for mission world-wide.
